Improvement points:

- Rath Yatra invitations should be circulated more rigorously and at least earlier by a month.
- More number of volunteers should be identified well in advance. There should be mock exercise for volunteers.
- Jain samaj, Gujurati Samaj, Marwadi sangh and Bengali associations should be invited and involved well in advance.
- Posters and banners should have been readied before a month so that they can be visibly kept for a longer period of time and thus can influence more.
- We should be more efficient at controlling crowd during chariot pulling procession.
- Cordon discipline should be strictly maintained.
- There should be first aid, a water tanker, Ambulance, backup generator for the procession.
